

Laricina Energy Ltd is a privately held, Calgary based company that is creating value by developing Canada's oil sands using innovative *in situ* technologies.

Founded in 2005, we have a diverse portfolio of oil sands assets at varied stages of development, in a variety of reservoir environments and geological character. Laricina's large concentrated resource base holds approximately 4.6 billion net recoverable barrels of bitumen.

Our plan includes a staged approach to expand production beyond 600,000 gross barrels of bitumen per day. The company holds 2 of the top 15 *in situ* oil sands developments, Saleski and Germain, which combined make up one of the largest *in situ* development platforms in the industry.

Initial development projects have been approved by the ERCB and Alberta Environment with steam injection underway at Saleski and construction launched at Germain.

Laricina has raised close to \$1.3 billion in equity financings since inception and has built solid senior management and technical teams as well as established key technical partnerships with industry, educational institutions and government. Laricina is a responsible energy company that will contribute supply to the growing demand for crude oil through *in situ* oil sands development with the assistance of an exceptionally skilled and dedicated staff.
